- **HS Codes:** Rawbamboo (1401), Furniture (9403), Handicrafts (4602)
- **Packaging:** Corrugated boxes, moisture-resistant, palletized for furniture
- **Councils:** EPCH(handicrafts), APEDA (food) - 15,000-6,000 fees

## Key Challenges

- Quality consistency and modern machinery gaps
- High transport costs from North East
